CCU Kids CAFÉ Program Official Rules

- Co-op Credit Union membership eligibility required.
- Youth 17 and under are eligible to participate.
- Stamp cards will be available at each CCU lobby location. Interested participants may ask a Member Service Representative or Member Account Representative for a card, and that employee will then write the participant's name and the date it was initially received by the participant on the card.
- At least two Financial Wellness stamps are required per stamp card to be eligible for prizes. There are no other requirements on types of stamps to complete a card.
- Youth participant must be present at a credit union office for all Financial Wellness-related and Educational Enrichment-related stamps on stamp cards.
- Only CCU employees may stamp and date completed square for Financial Wellness and Educational Enrichment categories.
- Parents/guardians/community members may sign and date completed squares for Community Involvement and Active Lifestyle categories.
 Signers also should include one word description of activity completed.
- Youth participant must be present for all prize redemptions.
- Grand prize drawings will start in 2019 and be held on the second Friday of April and the third Thursday of October. Entered stamp cards from all CCU locations will be drawn from drawing bin in lobby of CCU's Black River Falls office, located at 100 E. Main St., Black River Falls, WI 54615.
 Youth winner will be contacted via phone number or e-mail on file of parent/guardian who is joint on youth's account.
- Prizes outlined are final. No substitutions.
- Odds of winning will depend upon the number of entries received.
- All judges' decisions are final.

Each time you complete a stamp card, you receive your choice of a participation reward: Either a CCU swag bag with goodies inside or a gift certificate to a local business.




Participants earn stamps and receive a participation reward when completing a stamp card, which has 10 stamp slots.

Financial Wellness

Start saving! It's never too early to focus on saving your money. What can you do to earn a financial wellness stamp?



- Open an account at CCU if you aren't already a member.
- If you're already a member, you can open a new account, like a new savings or certificate.
- Deposit of at least \$5. Maximum of one stamp-earning deposit per day.
 Only CCU employees can stamp and date completed square.

Educational Enrichment

Always keep learning – there are so many ways! To earn a stamp, you can show us:



- You've completed the Junior Achievement program.
- Your quarterly report card.
- That you've been named Student of the Month or otherwise been academically honored by your school.
- You've participated in a coloring contest.
 Only CCU employees can stamp and date completed square.

At least two Financial Wellness stamps are required per submitted stamp card.

There are no other requirements on types of stamps to complete a card.
