
CCU eSuite: Did You Know?

CCU Mobile gives you the ability to temporarily disable your card if you notice an unfamiliar

transaction, misplace your debit card or have lost your card. Just log in to your CCU Mobile app, press "Card Controls" in the menu and at the touch of a button, you can disable or enable your debit card.

CCU Online can show members with a Reward Checking account their current Debit Card Swipe Count for the current period. Log in to CCU Online, select "Account Services" then click "Debit Card Swipe Count".
